



## **COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) SECOND PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE**

Summit County Council will hold a public hearing to discuss the projects determined to be applied for in the CDBG Small Cities Program in the Program Year 2016. Project 1: High Valley Water Company would like to replace the existing 242 meters with remote meters. They would like to purchase the meters, the hand-held reader, software and training services. Project 2: Peoa Pipeline Water Company would like to replace 1,200 lineal feet of 6" water line with 10" PVC water line, 12 services, 2 fire hydrants, 4 gate valves, approximately 1,200 square feet of asphalt repair, and all necessary appurtenances. Project 3: Summit County Senior Services would like to purchase kitchen equipment, furniture and necessary fixtures to guarantee the new space at the Kamas Services Building is efficient for the operation of the South Summit senior program. Comments will be solicited on each of these project's scope, implementation, and effects on residents.

The hearing will begin at 6:00 P.M. on May 4, 2016, and will be held at the Summit County Courthouse, 60 North Main Street, Coalville, UT 84017.
