Voter Information Pamphlet

In compliance with the Transparency of Ballots Proposition Act, Title 59, Chapter I, Part 16, Utah Code Annotated 1953, as amended, Summit County must post all arguments and rebuttal arguments on the Statewide Electronic Voter Information website and in a prominent place on the County website www.summitcounty.org for thirty days consecutive before the Election.

By September 6, 2016

- Eligible voters must file **request** to provide arguments either for or against ballot proposition.
 - File with County Clerk: kentjones@summitcounty.org

By September 9, 2016

- Eligible voters must file **arguments** for or against ballot proposition
 - File with County Clerk: kentjones@summitcounty.org
 - County Clerk places one argument for and one against in the Voter Information Pamphlet.

By September 26, 2016

- Eligible voters must file **rebuttal** arguments for Voter Info Pamphlet
 - Rebuttals to be filed with County Clerk: kentjones@summitcounty.org

September 26 – October 24, 2016

- Voter information pamphlet must be mailed to every household in the County.

October 7, 2016

- County Clerk posts arguments and rebuttals on the Statewide Electronic Voter Information Website and the County Website

Public Meetings & Ballot Information

September 26 – November 4, 2016

- Public meetings will be held at 6 p.m. during two County Council meetings no more than 45 days but at least 4 days before the Election (dates to be determined).

October 24, 2016

- County Clerk posts the actual ballots in the Park Record and on the Utah Public Notice Website.
