



PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

CREATION OF AGRICULTURE PROTECTION AREA

Summit County has received an application from Bill Battersby to create an Agriculture Protection Area in accordance with Section 11-1-3 of the Eastern Summit County Development Code and Section 17-41 of the Utah State Code. The proposal involves Parcels NS-1114 (3.48 acres), NS-1116 (313.47 acres) and NS-1127 (31.79 acres) located in Summit County. This application is available for public inspection at the Summit County Department of Community Development, 60 North Main Street, Coalville, Utah, during regular business hours.

Any person affected by the establishment of the proposed Agriculture Protection Area may file a written request for modification of the proposal or written objections to the proposal with Summit County within fifteen (15) days of the date of the notice. All comments must be received by 5:00 p.m., September 30, 2014.

The proposal will be reviewed by the Summit County Agriculture Protection Advisory Board on September 30, 2014 at 7:00 p.m. at the Summit County Courthouse 60 North Main Street, Coalville, Utah.

The proposal will be reviewed by the Eastern Summit County Planning Commission on September 4, 2014 at 6:00 p.m. at the, Kamas City Hall, 170 North Main Street, Kamas, Utah.
