## **New Process Creates Easier Streamlined Inspections at Summit County**

*Coalville* – With the 2015 construction season accelerating into springtime, Summit County Community Development Department has streamlined its processes to make it easier for contractors to schedule inspections. Builders can now schedule inspections with one quick phone call to the new inspection hotline number (435) 336-3124 and providing basic building permit information.

The new inspection hotline will prompt the caller to leave a permit number, contact name and phone number, the subdivision and lot number, the address and owner's last name and the type of inspection they are seeking. The calls get screened each day and assigned to an inspector. For the convenience of the builders and property owners, the next day's inspections will be posted on the County Building Department website after 5:00 p.m. each work day.

This newly implemented process creates an easy-to-access, hassle-free, and predictable system for setting up inspections. "We are pleased to launch this new system for the public to utilize when requesting inspections," said Patrick Putt, Community Development Director. "Happy builders have hammers in their hands, not telephones on hold. Our goal is to keep them building, not waiting."
