



VEHICLES CAN CAUSE WILDFIRE



Never Park or Drive on Dry Vegetation - There are hot components under vehicles, that when in contact, can cause fires. This includes recreation vehicles.



Check for Dragging Equipment - Secure trailer chains and double check under your vehicle and trailer to make sure nothing is dragging.



Maintain Spark Arrestors - Internal combustion engines (that are not highway vehicles) require a spark arrestor. Know how to check and clean them.



Check Your Brakes - Severely worn brakes can result in metal on metal contact, throwing sparks.



Properly Inflate Tires - If you hit a bump on a road/trail, the wheel may come in contact with with ground and cause sparks.



Be Ready - Always carry a shovel and fire extinguisher in your vehicle or ATV.
