



SHOOTING CAN CAUSE WILDFIRE



Place Your Targets on Dirt -

Use a backdrop free of dry vegetation and rocks to shoot toward.



Use Safe Targets - Shooting steel targets or rocks may throw sparks.



Ammunition Type Matters - Steel core and FMJ rounds have the highest potential to start fires due to ricochets of hot fragments.



Exploding Targets - The blast from an exploding target can spread hot fragments into the surrounding vegetation starting a fire.



Incendiary or Tracer Rounds - Tracers or other rounds that "burn" are illegal in the State of Utah.
