Curbside Recycling**

WHAT CAN YOU RECYCLE?

All Plastics #1 - #7

Recycle rinsed PLASTIC SOFT DRINK BOTTLES and PLASTIC MILK CONTAINERS. Caps and lids left on the bottles are O.K. Please rinse all bottles. This includes plastic shopping bags.

Aluminum Beverage Cans

Recycle all ALUMINUM CANS. Crushing cans will help to conserve space in your bin. Rinsing cans is advisable to keep your bin from getting sticky and attracting insects.

Newspapers

Recycle NEWSPAPERS. Stack them and place them in your Recycling bin. If you have extra papers, put them beside your bin bundled with something heavy (e.g. a rock) on top to hold them down. Inserts from your newspaper are O.K. to include as well.

All Cardboard

Old cardboard boxes must be broken down or cut to fit inside your recycling bin. Waxed cardboard is acceptable.

Magazines, Junk Mail, etc. *(Currently markets exist for these materials, however, it may change.)*

Staples and paper clips are O.K. to leave on.

Tin Cans

Recycle TIN CANS. Please be sure to rinse your cans. Crushing cans will help provide more space in your bin. Labels left on the cans are O.K.

When and Where???

- ❖ **Your recycling day is the same day as your garbage day. Please place your automated recycling container on the roadside near the curb by 7:00 am on your garbage day.**
- ❖ Place your automated recycling container about three feet or so on either side of your garbage container. This will allow both our garbage driver and recycle driver to access the containers much easier.

Why Can't More be Recycled????

NO GLASS or STYROFOAM! While there are more materials that are recyclable, yet were not listed above; recycling is dependent upon available markets. Glass is a recyclable material, however, in Utah the revenue received from the sale of glass is not enough to cover all of the costs for collecting, processing, and transporting glass material to a buyer. As viable markets and collection options develop for glass and other materials, we will add them to the program. Materials other than those listed above **will not be collected** and will be left in your recycling container.
